1. Peel the bananas and cut each banana in half. Now slice each half in half crosswise, you have 8 pieces of banana in total.

2. Carefully insert the popsicle sticks into the bottom of each banana, then place them on the prepared baking sheet.

3. Place the bananas in the freezer until they are completely frozen.

4. Dip the bananas into the yogurt. Place 3 mini chocolate chips on the ghost bananas to make the eyes and mouth.

5. Return to the freezer for 20 more minutes.

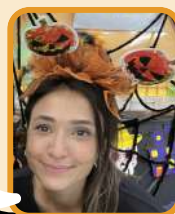
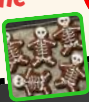

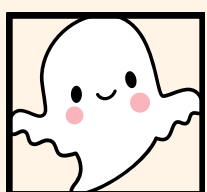
- Halloween traditions date back to **2,000 years ago**.

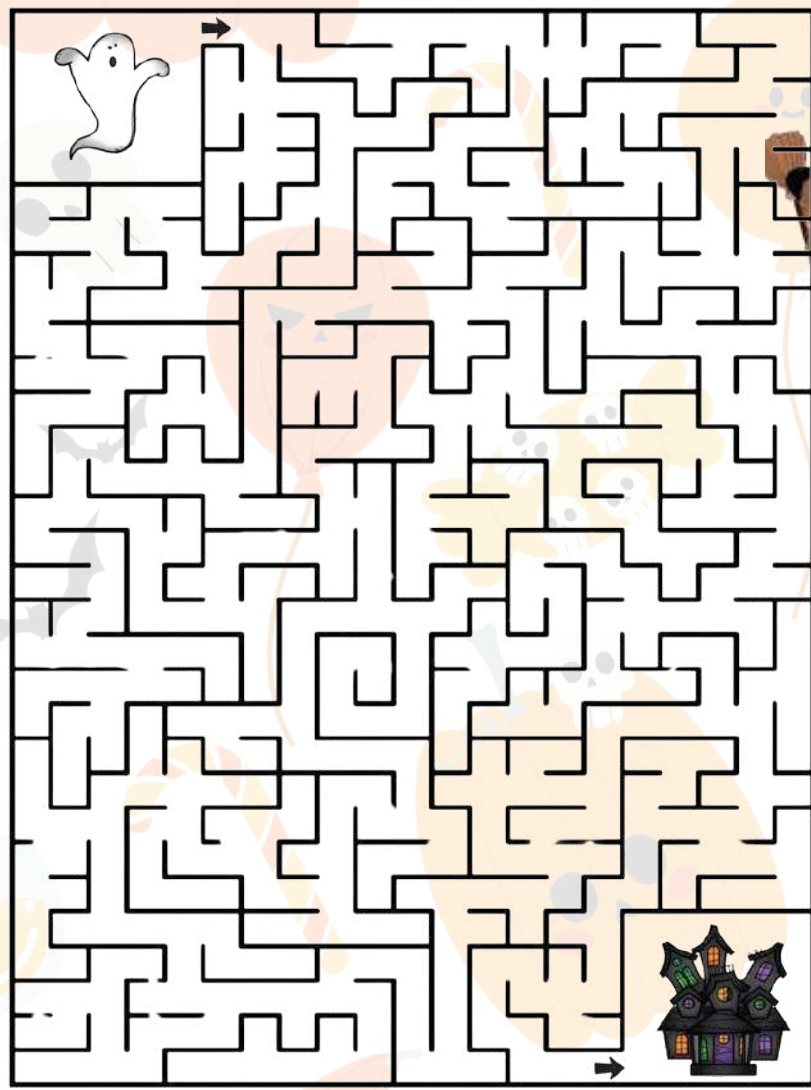
